Needs much TLC. Being used to prop up folding chairs. If you are good at woodworking, this car is for you.

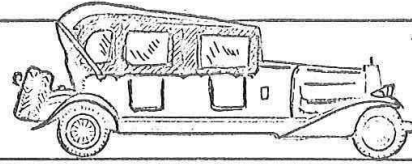


1963 Corvair Spyder.

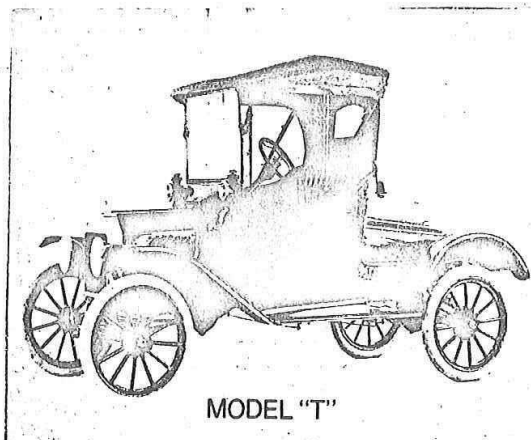
