

OCAC CAR SHOW MINUTES

The April 1, 2015 meeting was called to order by chairman, Jerry Barton with 20 people in attendance.

On Sunday, participant entry will be done from the west gate with the parking starting from the south end of the parking lot. The photographer will be on the north east side to get pictures of the cars as they enter. Guest will walk in through the south gate. Entry directions will be put in the registration packets.
